SPECIFICATIONS

Model 8355WCW barrier-free combination shower and eye/face wash shall include an AXION® MSR eye/face wash head shall feature inverted directional laminar flow which achieves Zero Vertical Velocity™ supplied by an integral 4.2 gpm flow control. Unit shall also include the AXION MSR hydrodynamic design stainless steel showerhead with 20 gpm flow control supplied from the wall, a fully recessed wall mounted 18 Gauge, Type 304 stainless steel deep-drawn cabinet, wheelchair accessibility, and chrome-plated brass pull-down valve with easy access in-line strainer. Unit shall also include brass pipe and fittings, a front-access maintenance panel, universal sign, 1" NPT(F) inlet. Operating pressure is 30 - 90 psi (2.1 - 6.2 bar).

APPLICATIONS

Where the eyes, face, or body of any person may be exposed to injurious or corrosive materials, suitable facilities for quick drenching or flushing of the eyes, face, and body shall be provided within the work area for immediate emergency use. Emergency eye/face wash facilities and deluge showers shall be in unobstructed and accessible locations that require no more than 10 seconds for the injured person to reach. Model 8355WCW is certified by CSA to meet the ANSI Z358.1 Standard for Emergency Eyewash and Shower Equipment.

AXION® MSR eye/face wash head (patent pending) uses an inverted directional laminar flow to sweep contaminants away from the vulnerable nasal cavity.


